New University Entrance Requirement from 2014

From 2014, there will be a new university entrance (UE) requirement. Students will use this new UE to enter degree-level programmes from 2015. The new UE requirement will continue to be the **minimum** requirement for entry to university.

From 2014, students will need all of the following to be awarded UE:

- attain NCEA Level 3
- achieve 14 credits at Level 3 in each of three subjects from the list of approved subjects:

Accounting Biology **Business Studies** Classical Studies Chemistry Computing Design (Art) Drama **Economics Physics** English French Geography Graphics History Japanese Home Economics Calculus Media Studies Music **Statistics** Painting (Art) Printmaking (Art) Technology Physical Education **Education for Sustainability**

- achieve **UE numeracy** 10 credits at Level 1 and above from specific achievement standards, or three specific numeracy unit standards
- achieve UE literacy 10 credits (five in reading and five in writing) at Level 2 and above from specific standards.

Current University Entrance Requirement until 2014

Students will use the current UE to enter degree level programmes up to and including 2014.

Up to 2013, students will need all of the following to be awarded UE:

• achieve 14 credits at level 3 in each of two subjects from the list of approved subjects.

- achieve 14 credits from a combination of any two subjects at Level 3.
- achieve **UE numeracy** 14 credits at Level 1 and above in specified numeracy standards.
- achieve UE literacy –in 8 credits (four in reading and four in writing) at Level 2 and above from specified English and Te Reo standards.
